Dear Family, Residents, Staff and Volunteers,

There are no restricted Local Government Areas.

- You can now enter a residential aged care facility if you have been in Greater Brisbane since 2 January 2021. Certain restrictions continue to apply to residential aged care facilities under the Aged Care Direction.

Overview

Visitors, staff or volunteers are not permitted entry if the following apply:

- feeling unwell
- have been diagnosed with COVID-19 or asked to quarantine
- have returned from overseas in the last 14 days (excluding safe travel zone countries)
- have had contact with a person with COVID-19 in the last 14 days
- have visited a COVID-19 hot spot in the last 14 days or since the hotspot was declared (whichever is shorter)
- have been tested for COVID-19 and is waiting for the result (except for tests due to surveillance testing obligations)
- has COVID-19 symptoms of fever (37.5 degrees or more), cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, loss of smell or taste, runny nose, diarrhoea, nausea, vomiting or fatigue.

You may enter Wongaburra Society if you do not fit into any of the above categories.

Visitors are to:

- wash their hands before entering and leaving the facility
- stay 1.5 metres away from others where possible

follow requests from the staff to help keep staff and residents safe
